March 12, 2018

Call to Order

The Clearmont Town Council met in regular session at the Clearmont Town Hall, March 12, 2018. Mayor Chris Schock called the meeting to order at 6:04 P.M.

Approval of Minutes

Mayor Schock reported that the Railroad Quiet Zone is being worked on by the engineers at this time, and project should occur during the Spring of 2019.

Mayor Schock reported that the WWDC Level II Study is under way. Discussion was held.

Mayor Schock reported that it is time to advertise for the summer maintenance help position. Position will be from June 1, 2018 through August 17, 2018.

Mayor Schock reported that it is time to start working on the budget, since the Direct Distribution has been passed through legislature. Budget Work Session was scheduled for March 26, 2018.

Clerk/Treasurer, Krysti Dycus reported that she will be turning in a pre-application for a Community Development Block Grant through the Wyoming Business Council to assist the Clear Creek Recreation District with handicap accessibility project.

Clerk/Treasurer, Krysti Dycus reported that the Wyoming Arts Council Rural Arts Access Grant was approved for \$750.00 to cover the music expense for Clearmont Days.

Clerk/Treasurer, Krysti Dycus reported that she took a lot of notes and learned a lot at the WAM Winter Convention.

John Kiser, Maintenance reported that he got the 1995 GMC power steering and 4-Wheel drive repaired, but is now having an oil pressure problem. He will take the truck back next time he goes to town.
