Councilor Poppenga moved to approve Ordinance #112 on second reading - An ordinance of the Town of Clearmont stating the rates of public works utilities, including water, sewer and garbage fees. Effective July 1, 2018. Motion seconded by Councilor Buhr. Motion carried 5-0.

Councilor Poppenga moved to approve Resolution 2018-4, a Resolution adopting a fee for dumpster usage at the Town of Clearmont Landfill with changes. Motion seconded by Councilor Switzer. Motion carried 5-0.
