Call to Order

The Clearmont Town Council met for a regular meeting at the Clearmont Town Hall, December 17, 2018. Mayor Greg Rohrer called the meeting to order at 6:04 P.M.

Attendance

Councilors present were as follows: Mayor Rohrer, Councilwoman Betz, Councilman Buhr, and Councilwoman Switzer. Also present were Krysti Dycus, Town Clerk, John Kiser, Maintenance. Councilman Poppenga was absent.

Approval of Current Agenda

Councilwoman Betz moved to approve the current agenda. Motion seconded by Councilwoman Switzer. Motion carried 4-0.

Approval of Minutes

Councilman Buhr moved to approve the November 19, 2018 work session and regular meeting minutes and December 6, 2018 Special Meeting minutes. Motion seconded by Councilwoman Switzer. Motion carried 4-0.

Approval of Bills

Councilwoman Switzer moved to approve the November 2018 bills. Motion seconded by Councilman Buhr. Motion carried 4-0.

Krysti Dycus, Clerk/Treasurer provided the council with Quarterly Revenue and Expenditure worksheets, as well as the CAPTAX Spreadsheet. Discussion was held.

Reports

Mayor Rohrer thanked Powder River Energy Foundation for their donation to allow us to provide gift cards for the residents and businesses in town that decorated their homes. He will deliver them on Thursday evening or Friday morning.

Mayor Rohrer asked Krysti to post the holiday hours, so residents are aware.

Mayor Rohrer reminded council members of the WAM Winter Workshop February 20 through February 22, 2019 if they are interested in attending.

Councilwoman Switzer asked about where the town was with Collins Communications, they should be here this week to connect the town hall to the new satellite internet.

Councilwoman Switzer asked if the town owns the new water well yet. Mayor Rohrer explained the process that we are going through.

Krysti Dycus explained the Community Review process. She will forward contact information to the Mayor and council members for them to speak with the Story Community Foundation who has had one done.

Krysti Dycus discussed dates for Clearmont Days and the importance of council involvement for a successful celebration. She will continue to look for dates.

Mayor Rohrer stated that John Buell will be reading meters on December 26, 2018. If Derick needs to do snow removal during John Kiser's absence, Councilman Buhr will direct him.

Unfinished Business

Councilwoman Switzer moved to approve Job Descriptions with changes. Motion seconded by Councilman Buhr. Motion carried 4-0.

Councilwoman Betz moved to approve Ordinance #114, an ordinance of the Town of Clearmont to repeal ordinance # 113 in its entirety and pass a new ordinance on third and final reading. Motion seconded by Councilwoman Switzer. Motion carried 4-0.

New Business

Councilwoman Switzer moved to appoint Mayor Rohrer as the official voting delegate for the 2019 WAM Winter Workshop. Motion seconded by Councilwoman Betz. Motion carried 4-0.


Councilwoman Betz moved to table the Mountain West Farm Bureau quotes until we have more detailed information. Motion seconded by Councilman Buhr. Motion carried 4-0.
